ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA

The Dennis Waldman Scholarship is open to Canadian students in their graduating year from either a Jewish or a public secondary school who intend to pursue university-level study. In either case, the applicant must provide a demonstrated history of involvement in Jewish communal life.

Selection criteria for the Dennis Waldman Scholarship include academic achievement, teacher references, extra-curricular activities, service to the community, and an essay. **Students applying for the scholarship must complete the application form and submit all required documentation. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**

Please note that we are a small foundation that does not currently accept applications online. Your entire application must be assembled and submitted on paper to the firm that administers the Waldman Foundation: Sloan Partners at 4646 Dufferin Street, Suite 6, Toronto M3H 5S4. **Your application must be received (by mail or delivery) by the deadline, May 3, 2019.**

2. TRANSCRIPT

Include a copy of your most recent high school transcript, including final grades from previous years and grade 12 marks.

3. TEACHER REFERENCES

Please provide letters of reference from two teachers/community leaders in support of your application.

4. ESSAY

Please write a 300-500-word essay on the following topic and submit this essay with your application.

Write about a story that impressed you—a novel, a movie, or a play—where the main character makes a difficult choice. Why did the character make this choice? Do you agree or disagree with the decision? How did the story of this choice make an impression on you?

Please note that financial need is not a criterion for the Waldman Scholarship. Do not submit financial documents or statements attesting to financial hardship, as they will not be considered as part of the application.

INTERVIEW

Three or four finalists for the Dennis Waldman Scholarship will be interviewed by a committee consisting of members of the Board of Directors of the Dennis Waldman Foundation for Jewish Education. Skype/FaceTime interviews can be arranged for finalists from outside the Toronto area.

Please note that this application form cannot be submitted electronically. Please include all documents: extra-curricular activity statement, transcripts, references and essay.
